

## **Traditional Car Club of Doncaster - Autumn Closure Run 2017**

Thank you for participating in this special end of season run which I hope you will enjoy to the full, providing a varied range of roads along some interesting countryside you may all not know well.

The route is divided into two sections, the first (shorter) run covers a mere 30 miles and the longer run a total of 67 miles; you can make your own decision according to your time, the weather and your hunger to get to the Water Wheel Café/Bistro! Everyone will at least complete the first 20 miles at which point in the guide notes you will be given the option to go for the short or long route (the latter completed on separate sheets typed in blue ink). If you do opt for the longer route, don't forget to zero your trip meter at that point as indicated in the notes.

The route takes in A and B roads plus some minor country lanes, some of which are quite narrow, so please be beware of oncoming traffic and hidden junctions.

It is vital that participants do not bunch up together, creating convoys of cars. This is actually now a legal issue and can lead to prosecution and the possibility of accidents and undoubted congestion, particularly on the minor roads. You will gain so much more from the run if you enjoy it and use the guide notes provided. If you do get 'attached' to other cars on the run, please ensure you retain reasonable gaps between you. The more cars tag on together, you will be governed by the speed of the first vehicle. Also consider that if you just follow someone else and they get lost, you will also!

The route distances provided are a guide. Please remember that mileages may differ, trip meter to trip meter, car to car, so also use the signage and other useful notes provided to help you.

Please remember that in some areas mobile phone signals may be very poor or even non-existent. Garages may be few and far between (that are open on a Sunday), so please ensure you have sufficient fuel available before you start the run.

There is no 'panic' to get to the Water Wheel Café/Bistro as they are expecting us after 12 noon onwards so it doesn't matter what time you arrive as long as it is after 12 and before 4pm!

At the mini roundabout you can either take the quick/easy route via the motorway (well signed to your left), or turn right, over the Boothferry Bridge, driving through Rawcliffe, Thorne, Hatfield, etc.
